REGULATOR APPROVED CHANGE IN TARIFF PER UNIT OF ELECTRICITY. THIS ORDER OF THE REGULATOR REVOKES ORDER NO 2017/E48.

The following tariff charges shall become effective commencing **01 JUNE 2017**

INDUCTION METER USERS

The 2% discount is removed from Induction Meter Users for advance payment of bills.

1. Domestic Consumers will be charged with the following tariffs:

kWh	Usage charge	Debt charge	Energy Charge	Total Cost per Unit
All Units	\$ 0.26	\$ 0.10	\$ 0.51	\$ 0.87

2. Non Domestic Consumers will be charged with the following tariffs:

kWh	Usage charge	Debt charge	Energy Charge	Total Cost per Unit
All Units	\$ 0.36	\$ 0.10	\$ 0.51	\$ 0.97

PREPAYMENT METER USERS (CASHPOWER)

The 2% discount is removed from Prepayment Meter Users.

3. Domestic Consumers will be charged with the following tariffs:

kWh	Usage charge	Debt charge	Energy Charge	Total Cost per Unit
1 ~ 100	\$ 0.12	\$ 0.10	\$ 0.51	\$ 0.73
101 and over	\$ 0.26	\$ 0.10	\$ 0.51	\$ 0.87

4. Non Domestic Consumers will be charged with the following tariffs:

All Units	\$ 0.26	\$ 0.10	\$ 0.51	\$ 0.87

The Order approved changes in the Energy Charge based on fuel charges for the month of April 2017, in light of the contribution by Independent Power Producers.
