**Order of the Regulator No. 2016/E43**  
(Pursuant to section 20 of the Electricity Act 2010)

**REGULATOR APPROVED CHANGE IN TARIFF PER UNIT OF ELECTRICITY. THIS ORDER OF THE REGULATOR REVOKES ORDER NO 2016/E42.**

The following tariff charges shall become effective commencing **01 NOVEMBER 2016**.

### INDUCTION METER USERS

The 2% discount is removed from Induction Meter Users for advance payment of bills.

1. Domestic Consumers will be charged with the following tariffs:

kWh	Usage charge	Debt charge	Energy Charge	Total Cost per Unit
All Units	\$ 0.26	\$ 0.10	\$ 0.38	<b>\$ 0.74</b>

2. Non Domestic Consumers will be charged with the following tariffs:

kWh	Usage charge	Debt charge	Energy Charge	Total Cost per Unit
All Units	\$ 0.36	\$ 0.10	\$ 0.38	<b>\$ 0.84</b>

### PREPAYMENT METER USERS (CASHPOWER)

The 2% discount is removed from Prepayment Meter Users.

3. Domestic Consumers will be charged with the following tariffs:

kWh	Usage charge	Debt charge	Energy Charge	Total Cost per Unit
1 ~ 100	\$ 0.12	\$ 0.10	\$ 0.38	<b>\$ 0.60</b>
101 and over	\$ 0.26	\$ 0.10	\$ 0.38	<b>\$ 0.74</b>

4. Non Domestic Consumers will be charged with the following tariffs:
